

Here's a chance to enjoy shooting an as-issued metallic cartridge Military Rifle from any nation either vintage (the model first issued between 1863 and 1950), or modern (the model first issued 1951 or later). Maybe it's an M1 Garand, 303 British Enfield, 03 Springfield, Mauser, or another old war horse for vintage class, or an M1A, AR15 (M14 and M16 clones) or another for the modern class. **All rifles must be in military conformation!** The match is free but limited to 50 PPSA members.

This is an honor-system postal match where shooters complete a course of fire at any time during 6%-weeks from May 1^{st} to June 15^{th} , 2025, and mail targets to the match coordinator for scoring.

COURSE OF FIRE

Targets are a 19-inch bullseye and must be placed at 300 yards. Shooters will fire 20 rounds (5 prone, 5 sitting, 5 kneeling and 5 standing) at each of 2 targets for a total of 40 rounds.

CLASSES

There are four classes: Vintage Class Iron Sight, Vintage Class Scoped (e.g. original or repro sniper rifles), Modern Class Iron Sight, and Modern Class Scoped.

PRIZES

Prizes for each class: First Place \$100 Gift Card Second Place \$75 Gift Card Third Place \$50 Gift Card
